History: This was a 56 year old female who had a diagnosis of Stage IV non-small cell carcinoma of the lungs that metastasized to the bone. In addition, she was suffering from hypoxia. She received durable medical equipment that was arranged through Homelink prior to her beginning hospice services, which then began after elective treatment was completed.

- 11/29/06-nebulizer with reusable kit arranged through Homelink.
- 11/29/06 to 01/29/07, durable medical equipment for oxygen needs arranged through Homelink.
- 01/22/07 to 01/26/07, home hospice services provided by Larimer County Hospice (in network). The patient expired on 01/26/07 in her home.

Case Management Intervention:

- Referral received on 12/29/06 to review for hospice services.
- Communication with the hospice provider Larimer County Hospice, verified networks status. This hospice agency was willing to accept the patient even though she was actively being treated with Tarceva an oral cancer treatment. This treatment was to continue for an additional two weeks from 12/29/06.
- Reviewed durable medical equipment for medical necessity that was arranged through Homelink prior to case management involvement.
- Communication with the husband regarding the use of the durable medical equipment and hospice services beginning after chemo treatment was completed.
- Communication with Homelink regarding durable medical equipment and recommendations, pick up of Helios, and non-billed charges for gas portable while Helios was in home and for services from 01/17/07 to 01/22/07 prior to hospice beginning.
- Received signed notification form back from hospice provider.
- Notified the account that the patient expired.

Case Management Recommendations:

- 11/29/06-purchase of Nebulizer with reusable kit was arranged through Homelink and medically appropriate.

- 11/29/06 to 01/29/07, two months rental of oxygen concentrator, contents, liquid stationary and Helios portable arranged through Homelink were medically appropriate.
- 01/17/07-01/22/07, home hospice services provided by Hospice of Larimer County at the reported per diem rate of \$170 all inclusive was medically appropriate.
- This writer will close this file as services are no longer indicated.
