The following information was obtained from a phone conversation with Dr. Kelly's office (family practice) and a letter provided by Dr. Siocom's office (cardiology).

**History/Current Status:** This 56 year old male has a history of a myocardial infarction in 1995 and hypertension. In February 2005 he underwent a cardiac cath with stenting of the right coronary artery and left anterior descending artery without incident. He was evaluated by the cardiologist last on 11/11/06; he had undergone a stress test with very good exercise tolerance. His myocardial scan was improved compared to last year. His medication included Plavix (anti-platelets), aspirin, Zestril (hypertension), Toprol (betablocker), Ziac (hypertension) and Vytorin (hyperlipidemia). The family practice office reported that he was last seen 8/24/06 for a physical examination which was unremarkable; BP was normal. His last lipid panel was done in 2005; in April of 2006 his hand was x-rayed for joint pain but no treatment was indicated.

No other information was provided. The family practice office had no information in regards to any type of malignancy or cancer diagnosis or treatment (V76 code.)

### **Foreseeable Treatment**

Stress test  
Quarterly MD visits, lab work  
Medication

### **Potential Treatment**

Cardiac cath with or without intervention if symptoms appear.
